Guidelines of Prof A. R. Kamat Award for the

Best Ph.D. Thesis in Statistics

- 1. The Prof. A. R. Kamat award will be given every year to the student who has done Ph.D. in Statistics either in India or abroad. This award is open to all whether they are life-member of ISPS or not. If the candidate is not life-member and the candidate won the award, then the candidate should become a life-member by paying the life-membership fee. The worth of the award is Rs. 40,000/-. - 2. The awarded candidate will be invited to present his/her awarded talk during annual ISPS conference. The award certificate and the amount will be given to the candidate during the valedictory function of ISPS conference.
- 3. The candidates should be below 32 years on the due date of the award specified from time to time. Proof of age (scan copy of PAN or birth certificate or any valid certificate) should be given.
- 4. The duration of submission of the thesis in the respective Universities or Institutes should not be more than one year or duration date specified in flyer or brochure.
- 5. The last date of submission of the blinded version of the thesis (soft copy) with bio data of the candidate is on or before the due date and submitted to the Convener. The contact details of the Convener are provided in the ISPS Flyer.
- 6. Blinded version should not include candidate's name, guide's name, address, email address, name of the University/Institution and personal publications of the candidate. Thesis should include only the title, table of contents, chapters, and references in one PDF file
