ABOUT INDIAN SOCIETY FOR PROBABILITY AND STATISTICS (ISPS)

Eminent scholars belonging to the disciplines of Mathematical and Statistical Sciences laid the foundation for the origin of Indian Society for Theory of Probability and its Applications (ISTPA) when they met at Sri Venkateswara University in 1980. In the same year, the draft constitution of the Society was drawn up during the deliberation of the Conference held at the Indian Institute of Technology Bombay (IITB). Later, in 1981, it was registered in Bombay with its official address at the Department of Mathematics, IIT Bombay. The Society was renamed as Indian Society for Probability and Statistics (ISPS) in 1985. It has attracted many researchers and scholars for enrolment as life members over the years and presently, the strength has crossed 1750. The society takes every effort to enhance this number inviting young faculty, research scholars and students of Statistics across the country. ISPS publishes the Journal (JISPS) Bi-Annual by Springer Publication with Impact factor 1.2 and it is ranked as Q3 Journal. Annual Convention / Conference / Workshop / Symposium of ISPS is being organized every year in one of the reputed national universities where the Department of Statistics exists. The events in every conference/convention include memorial lectures, endowment lectures, invited talks, presentation of research papers for Six awards including ISPS-Young Statistician and presentation of contributory research papers. Distinguished Statistician Award Fellow of ISPS award, Prof. C.R. Rao, Life Time Achievement Award, has been instituted and is being presented to an eminent personality in recognition of his/her scholarly contributions to the development of Statistics. Society obtained 80G, ISO Certificate & Affiliated to IMS, USA. Among all statistical societies in India today ISPS Ranked number one.

I am extremely happy to inform you that on the eve of Prof. G. Sankarnarayanan (Founder President of ISPS) Birth Centenary Celebrations Prof. A.M. Mathai Emeritus Professor, MC Gill University, Canada has laid the foundation stone for Data Science Centre of ISPS on 13th March 2023 in Tirupati.

I am further pleased to inform you that Indian Society for Probability and Statistics (ISPS) has been given land by Sri Venkateswara University Teachers Co-operative House Building Society Limited (SVUTCHBS Ltd) in the name of Multipurpose Hall (Sri Venkateswara Nilayam) -cum -Office that can be used for Society's Office, ISPS Office, education and training Programmes, Community and Spiritual needs of SVUTCHBS Ltd besides the requirements of ISPS Head Quarters, Tirupati.

The general body of SVUTCHBS Ltd has discussed and accepted the proposal of ISPS to use the facilities at the convention building for ISPS office, Meetings, educational Data Science Programmes, on providing funds for the construction of the convention Hall. The executive committee and general body of ISPS discussed elaborately and sanctioned an amount of Rs. 15 lakhs from the ISPS funds for the construction of the ground floor of the convention hall spanning an area of 2300 sft. and in the first floor about 1000 sft with an estimated cost Rs. 45 lakhs. Further to inform you that in the First Phase the Ground floor ISPS Office Cum Convention Hall and in the first floor the Statistics Consultancy Service Cell and one Guest room and it will be completed by December 2023. In the second phase one computer laboratory 6 Guest Rooms and one Self Study Library Hall will be constructed in near future. Totally it will be around 8000 sq. ft. with lift facility.

To materialize the dream of office-cum-Data Science Centre of ISPS in its Head Quarters in spiritual and temple city Tirupati, the remaining amount need to be generated through donations and voluntary contributions from Philanthropists for the purpose of construction.
